"AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH, CREATING SECTION 2-18 (A) PROVIDING TEMPORARY BENEFITS TO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES INJURED IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR EMPLOYMENT"

#13-07

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst have recognized the need to limit benefits to work-related injuries to the statutory benefit received under N.J.S.A. 34:15-12 *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 34:15-12(a) provides that for injuries producing temporary disability for a period of more than seven days, seventy percent (70%) an employee's average weekly wage, not to exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the Statewide Average Weekly Wage (SAWW) or fall below the minimum rate of twenty percent (20%) of the SAWW shall be provided to the employee during the period when a worker is unable to work and is under active medical care; and

WHEREAS, it is important for the municipality to comply with the Best Practice Guidelines promulgated by the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the best practice guidelines seek to limit benefits to an injured employee to the statutory guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst find it necessary to comply with the Best Practice Guidelines;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough of Lakehurst, County Of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. Borough Ordinance Section 2-18, which was reserved, is hereby created entitled Employee Benefits and shall be amended to create subsection 2-18 a to be entitled *Disability Benefits* and to provide as follows:

- a. At the onset of a compensatable disability as provided for by N.J.S.A. 34:15-12 *et. seq.*, the employee is responsible for filing the proper documents as soon as it becomes apparent that the compensatable disability will make the employee eligible for state temporary disability benefits under N.J.S.A. 34:15-12 *et. seq.*
- b. Subject only to a Collective Bargaining Agreement existing at the effective date of this Ordinance, compensation of a municipal employee from the Borough who is disabled and qualified to receive temporary disability benefits shall be limited as provided by N.J.S.A. 34:15-12 *et. seq.* as may be amended

- c. Upon application of an injured employee, and on good cause and extraordinary circumstances shown, at the sole discretion of the governing body, by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the governing body eligible to vote, an employee may seek up to an additional thirty percent (30%) of his or her salary from the municipality for a period of not more than six (6) months.
- d. It is the intent of the Borough that its policies and procedures adhere to the policies and procedures established by the State of New Jersey concerning the benefits to be provided under the state disability program. In the event that the current policy conflicts with the State's, then the state's will prevail.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION III. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2014 and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE 2013-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ADOPTING, AMENDING, SUPPLEMENTING, AND CODIFYNG THE MANDATORY AND RANDOM ALCOHOL AND DRUG TESTING POLICY OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough of Lakehurst, New Jersey, shall henceforth require all volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, to undergo mandatory and random alcohol and drug testing administered by a professionally trained, reputable contractor/firm or police department hired by the Borough of Lakehurst in order to demonstrate the ability to perform their duties without any dependence on illegal substances.

SECTION 2: Definitions.

- a. "Alcohol" shall mean any substance with an alcohol concentration of 0.04% or more as defined in N.J. Stat. § 39:3-10.13.
- b. "Alcohol test" shall mean any test administered for the purpose of determining the presence or absence of alcohol in a person's body.
- c. "Contractor/Firm" shall mean any agency designated by the Borough of Lakehurst to conduct drug screening tests for the purpose of detecting controlled dangerous substances.
- d. "Controlled dangerous substances" shall mean any substance listed in Schedules I through V in Sections 5 through 8 of P.L. 1970, C.226 (N.J.S.A. 24:21-5 through 24:21-8) and in Section 4 of P. L. 1971, C.3 (N.J.S.A. 24:21-8.1). The term shall not include tobacco, tobacco products, distilled spirits, wine, or malt beverages as they are defined or used in N.J.S. 33:1-1 et seq. Controlled dangerous substances are classified as any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of substances having a potential for abuse associated with a depressant effect on the central nervous system.
- e. "Drug test" shall mean any test administered for the purpose of determining the presence or absence of a controlled dangerous substance in a person's body.
- f. "Employee" shall mean all individuals, both appointed and non-appointed, who are hired or who are seeking to be hired by the Borough of Lakehurst.
- g. "Employee Assistance Program" shall mean and refer to the Borough of Lakehurst's program which is designed to help employees resolve personal problems which have an adverse effect on their job performance.
- h. "Medical facility" shall mean a laboratory wherein drug tests are conducted on samples.
- i. "Prescription or Non-prescription medication" shall mean a drug prescribed for use by a duly licensed physician, dentist or other medical practitioner licensed to issue prescriptions, or drug that is authorized for general distribution and use in the treatment of human diseases, ailments, or injuries, pursuant to the "Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act," 52 Stat. 1040 (21 U.S.C. 301 et seq.).

- j. "Random" shall mean and only refer to the dates and times selected by the Borough of Lakehurst and shall not refer to the method or selection process of selecting the individuals chosen for the drug and alcohol testing.
- k. "Reasonable suspicion" shall mean circumstances that would induce a reasonably intelligent individual to believe that a specific condition, in this case the use of drugs, exists.
- 1. "Volunteers" shall mean all individuals who voluntarily offer themselves or their services and are hired or seek to be hired by the Borough of Lakehurst and are either appointed or non-appointed, on an unpaid or uncompensated basis, who utilize the Borough of Lakehurst equipment or who work with or have any contact with children.

SECTION 3: It shall be a violation of this Ordinance to release information obtained through an alcohol or drug test except to the Borough Clerk or Borough Administrator, the volunteers, the employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment. The result of an alcohol or drug test may not be used in any civil or criminal proceeding against the individuals who have submitted to the test.

SECTION 4: The Contractor/Firm or the police department shall be responsible for performing the urinalysis testing of volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, and submitting findings of the same to the Borough of Lakehurst's Clerk or Borough Administrator.

SECTION 5: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, shall be required to submit to a mandatory and random alcohol and drug test for the purpose of determining the presence or absence in the body of the above-mentioned person.

SECTION 6: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, who refuse to submit to an alcohol and/or drug test, shall be denied employment. In the case of a new employee, the test shall be administered immediately prior to the last application procedure before employment is offered to the applicant.

SECTION 7: It is hereby mandatory for all new employees to undergo alcohol and drug testing.

SECTION 8: The test required under this legislation shall be provided by the Borough of Lakehurst which shall enter into contract with approved medical facility to administer the tests.

SECTION 9: Prior to or at the time of the drug test, the volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, will be given the opportunity to submit medical documentation to verify the person's use of a prescription or non-prescription medication.

SECTION 10: Directors, Department Heads, and Managers who suspect volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, of using alcohol or drugs shall report the name(s) of those person(s) to the Borough of Lakehurst's Clerk or Borough Administrator who in turn shall monitor the case. The Directors, Department Heads, and Managers will immediately report any suspensions to the Administrator or clerk. Directors, Department Heads, and Managers that observe behavior constituting reasonable suspicion are required to institute testing and do not have the option of sending the volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, home as an alternative.

SECTION 11: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, will be required to submit to alcohol or drug testing when their work performance causes a reasonable suspicion that they are impaired due to current intoxication, drug or controlled substance abuse, or in cases where employment has been conditioned upon remaining alcohol, drug, or controlled substance fee following treatment.

SECTION 12: The following characteristic and/or factors may be used to form or establish reasonable individualized suspicion as cited above:

- a. Physical impairment or incapacitation;
- b. Excessive absenteeism:
- c. Chronic lateness:
- d. Deterioration of work habits;
- e. Reduced productivity;
- f. Confidential information concerning illegal drug use;
- g. Uncharacteristic behavior patterns.

SECTION 13: The refusal by volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and any individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, to submit to a urinalysis test when so ordered, based on reasonable suspicion, shall be the basis for disciplinary action, up to and including termination, imposed by the Borough of Lakehurst's Clerk or Borough Administrator.

SECTION 14: The manufacturing, distribution, dispensation, possession, and use of alcohol or unlawful drugs on the Borough of Lakehurst's premises or during work hours by volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, are strictly prohibited.

SECTION 15: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, must notify their supervisor within five (5) days of conviction for a drug or alcohol related violation, whether or not the violation occurred in the workplace.

SECTION 16: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, who are required to maintain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) are subject to random drug testing as required by the federal government.

SECTION 17: All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, using prescription drugs that may affect job performance or safety must notify their supervisor or Department Head who is required to maintain the confidentiality of any information regarding an individual's medical condition in accordance with the Health Insurance Portability and Protection Act. Borough personnel who hold a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) are subject to the provisions of the Commercial Driver's Licenses Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy. A program to assist employees, who may have a drug/alcohol problem, if appropriate, is provided through the Borough's medical benefit program.

SECTION 18: No prescription drug should be used by any person other than the individual to whom it is prescribed. Such substances or non-prescription (over-the-counter) drugs should be used only as prescribed or indicated. All volunteers, employees, both appointed and non-appointed, and all individuals utilizing Borough of Lakehurst equipment, are prohibited from consuming prescription drugs that are not

prescribed in their name on Borough property or while performing Borough business. Soliciting or distributing prescription drugs for or to other employees is also strictly prohibited.

SECTION 19: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 20: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 21: This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
