**BOND RESOLUTION NO. 20-142**

BOND RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$960,000 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 2020 AND THE SALE THEREOF TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND DETERMINING THE FORM AND OTHER DETAILS OF SUCH BONDS, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lakehurst, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Borough"), adopted the Bond Ordinance shown on Attachment A annexed hereto (collectively the "Bond Ordinance") on the date set forth therein and for water main improvements as described therein (the "Project") and authorizing the issuance of bonds in an aggregate principal amount of in excess of \$960,000 to finance the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has issued various Bond Anticipation Notes pursuant to the Bond Ordinance as set forth in Attachment A and the Borough desires to refund said notes through the issuance of the bonds hereinafter described pursuant to its participation in the Rural Development program (the "Program") of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Local Bond Law, constituting Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey (*N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq.*), governs the issuance of bonds by the Borough and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-27, the Borough is authorized to sell bonds by private sale to the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to issue bonds pursuant to the Bond Ordinance in order to permanently finance the Project and to sell said bonds to the United States of America.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorization for the Bonds and Projects to be Funded. Pursuant to the Local Bond Law and by virtue of the Bond Ordinances, the Borough hereby authorizes the sale

and issuance of general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount of \$960,000 as hereinafter set forth, to permanently finance the Project. The Bonds shall consist of one (1) series composed of \$960,000 General Improvement Bonds, Series 2020 (the "Bonds") issued pursuant to the Bond Ordinance.

Section 2. Details of the Bonds. (a) The Bonds shall be payable in seventy-nine (79) equal installments, commencing on April 13, 2021 and on each October 13th and April 13th thereafter, together with one (1) final installment on October 13, 2060, as set forth on Attachment B annexed hereto.

(b) The Bonds shall be dated their date of issuance, with the right of redemption prior to maturity at any time without penalty upon payment of all the unpaid principal then due plus interest due to the date of redemption.

(c) The Bonds shall be issued in one (1) certificate registered in the name of the United States of America and shall be payable at the office of Rural Development in Vineland, New Jersey.

(d) The Bonds shall be executed by the manual or facsimile signatures of the Mayor and Chief Financial Officer, under the official seal of the Borough affixed, imprinted or reproduced thereon and attested to by the manual signature of the Borough Clerk.

(e) The Bonds shall be payable in any coin or currency of the United States of America which at the time of payment is legal tender for the payment of public or private debts.

Section 4. Form of the Bonds. (a) The Bonds shall be in substantially the form as annexed hereto as Attachment C, subject to such modifications as are approved in the reasonable discretion of the Financial Officer in consultation with Bond Counsel, and consistent with applicable law.

(b) If any Bond is mutilated, destroyed, lost or stolen and replaced in accordance with the Local Bond Law, including specifically *N.J.S.A. 40A:2-36*, the owner thereof shall be responsible for all costs incurred in connection with the replacement thereof, including legal, printing and other related costs.

Section 5. Sale of the Bonds. The Borough hereby sells the Bonds at par value to the United States of America pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of this Resolution and the Loan Resolution adopted on May 21, 2020, a form of which is annexed hereto as Attachment D and the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference.



Section 6. Additional Matters. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The Bonds have not been heretofore sold or issued and the Bond Ordinance described herein has not been rescinded and now remains in full force and effect as authorization for the aggregate principal amount of the Bonds.

(b) The purposes for which the Bonds have been authorized to be issued are purposes for which bonds may lawfully be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law and are not purposes for which a deduction may be taken in any annual or supplemental debt statement of the Borough.

(c) The average period of usefulness of the Bonds authorized by the Bond Ordinance, as defined by N.J.S.A. 40A:2-22, is 40 years.

Section 7. Security for the Bonds. Any Bond issued pursuant to this Resolution shall be a general obligation of the Borough, and the Borough's full faith and credit are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on, and all other amounts due under, the Bonds, according to their terms, and, unless otherwise paid or payment provided for, an amount sufficient for such payment shall be inserted in the budget and a tax sufficient to provide for the payment thereof shall be levied and collected.

Section 8. Delegation of Authority. The Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to determine all matters in connection with the Bonds not determined by this or subsequent resolution, in consultation with Bond Counsel, and the manual signature of the Financial Officer upon the Bonds shall be conclusive as to such determinations. The Mayor, Clerk, and Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such documents as are necessary for the issuance and delivery of Bonds and to take such actions or refrain from such actions as are necessary for the issuance of the Bonds, in consultation with Bond Counsel.

Section 9. Closing and Delivery of the Bonds. The Borough shall cause the Bonds to be prepared and made ready for delivery on the Closing Date, which shall be on October 13, 2020, as agreed to by the Financial Officer. The delivery of and payment for the Bonds shall take place at the Borough Hall, or at such other place as is agreed to by the Financial Officer. At the Closing, the Borough will deliver the Bonds to the United States of America together with the other required documents and, subject to the terms and conditions hereof, the United States of

America will accept such delivery and pay the aggregate purchase price of the Bonds in immediately available funds.

Section 10. Application of Bond Proceeds. The proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to pay the costs of the Project, including the costs of issuance of said Bonds.

Section 11. Report on the Bonds. The Financial Officer is hereby directed to report in writing to the governing body of the Borough at the meeting next succeeding the date of delivery of the Bonds. Such report shall include the principal amount, description, interest rate and maturities of the Bonds sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 12. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$135,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, FULLY FUNDED BY THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND  
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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Borough of Lakehurst, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the following various improvements.

Sections 2. The sum of \$46,000 is hereby appropriated for the acquisition of Police vehicle, the sum of \$3,800 is hereby appropriated for Tasers, a sum of \$18,050 is hereby appropriated for Police radios, a sum of \$18,000 is hereby appropriated for a new roof on Borough Hall, a sum of \$7,000 is hereby appropriated for a mower, a sum of \$7,150 is hereby appropriated for street signs and the sum of \$35,000 is hereby appropriated for the road improvements (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be fully funded by the Capital Improvement Fund. The sum of \$135,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. The period of usefulness of the Improvements referred to in Section 2, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof, is not less than five years.

Section 4. The capital budget of the Borough of Lakehurst is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 5. The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements the Borough may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the Improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Borough of Lakehurst, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the following various improvements.

Sections 2. The sum of \$100,000 is hereby appropriated for the various improvements to the Water-Sewer Utility System (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be fully funded by the Capital Improvement Fund. The sum of \$100,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. The period of usefulness of the Improvements referred to in Section 2, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof, is not less than five years.

Section 4. The capital budget of the Borough of Lakehurst is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 5. The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements the Borough may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the Improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
