ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISTION OF UTILITY EQUIPMENT AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$92,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, FULLY FUNDED BY THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAKEHURST, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Borough of Lakehurst, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of a utility vehicle, a front-loading tractor, and related equipment.

Sections 2. The sum of \$92,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be fully funded by the Capital Improvement Fund. The sum of \$92,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. The period of usefulness of the Improvements referred to in Section 2, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof, is not less than five years.

Section 4. The capital budget of the Borough of Lakehurst is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 5. The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements the Borough may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the Improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that a 1% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$37,579 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; **and**,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lakehurst, in the County of Ocean, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Lakehurst shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$131,526.50 and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Borough of Lakehurst be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; **and,**

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; **and**,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.
